- Grilling permitted in designated areas only.

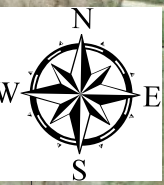
The following activities are prohibited in this park:

- Camping, which includes, without limitation, use of any tent, shelter, and/or other structure.
- Smoking.
- Possession and/or consumption of alcohol (except pursuant to a city-issued permit).
- Littering.
- Noise disturbances, including, without limitation, the following:
 - Unreasonably loud or raucous noise;
 - Noise which unreasonably disturbs or endangers the comfort, health, peace, or safety of reasonable persons of ordinary sensitivity; and/or
 - Any noise so harsh, prolonged, unnatural, or unusual in time or place as to create unreasonable discomfort to persons within the surrounding neighborhood.
- Fireworks, except as permitted under state law and otherwise authorized by the City.
- Cutting or removing trees, shrubbery, flowers, and/or grass.
- Use of motorized vehicles (except in designated parking areas).
- Commercial activity, except by permitted use.
